Potential Waste Collection Saving per Community with Franchising Waste Collection (aggregation)

Goshen Township Board of Trustees have been approached about bidding trash/recycling service for the entire township as a part of a cooperative agreement with 7 other Townships.

If Goshen Township chooses to "Bid" trash and recycling the cost to Goshen residents would be reduced by an estimate of between \$500,000 and \$700,000 a year township wide or around \$10 a month per resident (\$120 a year).

Some of the details of the proposed bid package are as follows:

- Basic service will be automated or semi-automated cart (waste hauler supplies containers)
- Each customer would receive a 95 gal waste cart picked up 1 x wk. at the curb (everyone gets 1 cart, 2nd at no cost on request)
- Addition of curbside recycling - Each customer would receive a 95 gal recycling cart picked up 2 x mo. at the curb (everyone gets 1 cart, 2nd at no cost on request)
- Extra carts available at additional costs
- Large item pickup once a month (limit 3 items per pick up)
- One unlimited large item pick once (1) a year
- Additional extra-large item pickup at additional costs
- Special price for hand service for non-automated self-owned containers
- Special price for backdoor hand service for handicapped/special needs
- Billing done by waste hauler
- Waste collection not mandatory, but you would have to use the Township's vendor for waste/recycling
