## GOSHEN TOWNSHIP RESOLUTION NO. R-005-2025

The Board of Trustees of Goshen Township, Clermont County, Ohio met in regular session on the 8th day of April, 2025 with the following members present:

M./Ms. Bob Hausermann moved for the adoption of the following Resolution:

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A NO PARKING AREA ON THE NORTH SIDE OF MARSH CIRCLE IN GOSHEN TOWNSHIP, CLERMONT COUNTY, OHIO

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Goshen Township has determined that parking on the north side of Marsh Circle, specifically up to 70 feet east of the apex of Shade Drive, poses a safety hazard due to limited visibility; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to ensure the safety of residents and motorists in the area by prohibiting parking in this location; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 505.17 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Board of Trustees has the authority to make regulations for vehicle parking in the township;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of Goshen Township, Clermont County, Ohio, that:

1. No parking shall be permitted on the north side of Marsh Circle, from the apex of Shade Drive extending 70 feet to the east.

- 2. This parking prohibition is established to ensure safe passage of motorists, pursuant to the authority granted under ORC 505.17.
- 3. The Township Fiscal Officer is directed to post a copy of this resolution within the township for thirty (30) consecutive days; the Township Hall, the Goshen Post Office, The Goshen Library, two Goshen businesses or schools, and on the web site and social media account of the township.
- 4. This resolution shall take effect thirty (30) days after the completion of the posting period.
- 5. Upon the effective date, the township shall install "no parking" signs in the designated area in accordance with the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (OMUTCD), as required by ORC 4511.09.
- 6. Law enforcement officers are authorized to enforce this parking prohibition and issue citations to violators in accordance with applicable state and local laws.
