Internet Auction Policy Notice

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code 505.10(D), Goshen Township Board of Trustees are required to adopt annually, a resolution which sets forth specific information about the manner in which they dispose of surplus or obsolete equipment owned by the township.

- 1.) The board contracts with govdeals.com to conduct all sales of surplus, obsolete, unneeded, or unfit-for-use equipment owned by the board: the particulars on how the internet sales are conducted can be found at that site;
- 2.) Bidding on all items to be sold by the board through govdeals.com will be listed on that site for a period of at least ten (10 calendar days), including Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays; All items are sold AS-IS and without any warranty.
- 3.) The board will publish a notice that is a summary of this resolution in newspaper of general circulation within the township, with the notice of its intent to dispose of said property by internet auction;
- 4.) The board will cause this resolution to appear on the township website(www.goshen-oh.gov); and,
- 5.) The board will post this notice in a conspicuous place that being the bulletin board in the lobby of the township hall. This notice shall be posted throughout the calendar year on the bulletin board in the township hall.
- 6.) All payments from the internet auction are to be made through govdeals.com.
- 7.) All items purchased from govdeals.com can be picked up in person. If an item is picked up in person, an appointment must be made with the Township Administrator or his/her designee. An item can be shipped at the discretion of the Township Administrator and his/her designee. If an item is shipped it will adhere to all terms and conditions of GovDeals.com. Goshen Township is not liable for any shipping related issues once the item leaves Goshen Township's possession. The purchaser furthermore understands that they are to pay shipping cost and assume all risk of loss or damage of items.
- 8.) Purchasers must provide a valid driver's license or other form of identification;
- 9.) Bidders will be notified of winning through e-mail and posted to the auction website and must pay for items within five (5) business days of being notified of being the successful bidder;
- 10.) The purchaser must pick up the item within ten (10) days of being notified as the successful bidder. If the item has not been paid for in the five (5) day period, it will be awarded to the next highest bidder. If the item is not picked up by the purchaser within ten (10) days of payment, the purchaser will be deemed to have abandoned the item of property and forfeited the purchase price paid.
