Short-Term Priorities (2026)

Internal Priorities:

- Add Flock cameras
- Implement and revise policies that meet the highest standards of professional and operational excellence
- Implement professional hiring and retention practices to support a strong, stable workforce
- Expand grant research and pursuit
- Develop capital improvement plans for each department
- Create internship and/or seasonal staffing programs
- Continue zoning workshops

External Priorities:

- Create a subdivision paving plan and assessment
- Complete updated Land Use Plan
- Improve traffic signage on township roads
- Update Zoning Resolution

Mid-Term Priorities (2027–2028)

Internal:

- Review levy structures and revenue models to meet demands of community growth

External:

- Enhance safety at high-risk intersections

Long-Term Priorities (2029–2030)

- Remain competitive with pay and benefits
- Expand staffing to meet growth
- Implement cemetery expansion

External:

- State Route 28 improvements
- Attract new businesses
- Construct Goshen Road sidewalks
- Clean up blighted properties
- Redevelop the downtown district
