



Goshen Township Citizens Police Academy Alumni Association (CPAAA)

The CPAAA was formed in 2010 to be a volunteer support group for the Goshen Police Department and the township. To be a member of the CPAAA, you must complete a Goshen Citizens Police Academy (CPA) Class which we offer once a year. Upon successful completion of the class, you may join the Alumni Association and begin giving back to Goshen Township.

During the class, students meet the majority of the Police Department staff as well as other township officials. Captain Don Hampton is the coordinator of the CPA class sessions and Chief Bob Rose is the coordinator for the CPAAA.

The CPAAA currently has over 100 members with about 30 members who are actively involved. The CPAAA holds monthly meetings, go on tours, hold fundraisers and volunteer to assist the Police Department in a number of activities and events.

To date, the CPAAA has collected and given back to the community, over \$120,000! Some of our donations include:

Shop with a Cop – We take 20 Goshen School children shopping with our officers and purchase gifts for the children, their siblings and parents. We have taken 290 children shopping and have spent over \$40,000.

Goshen PD Donations – We have donated over \$50,000 to the Goshen PD in equipment, gear, gift cards, etc.

Donations to Others – We have donated over \$30,000 to other Goshen Community members. Some of these include \$1,000 annual scholarship to a graduating Goshen Senior, Tornado Relief, Self Defense class gift bags, Food Pantry, Goshen Schools, Fire Department, Service Department and Admin staff gift cards, etc.
